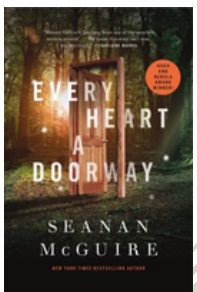
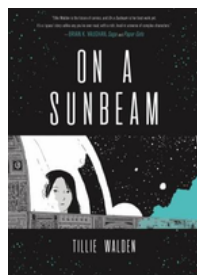


CALICO CAT COOKIES
