

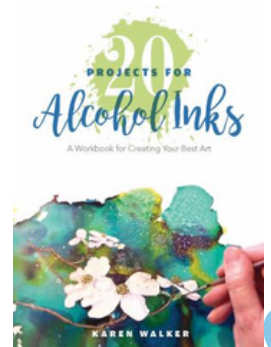
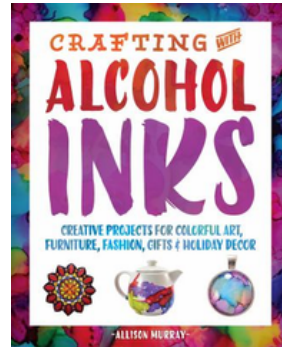

WATER YOUR PLANTS; DRINK FROM THE HOSE

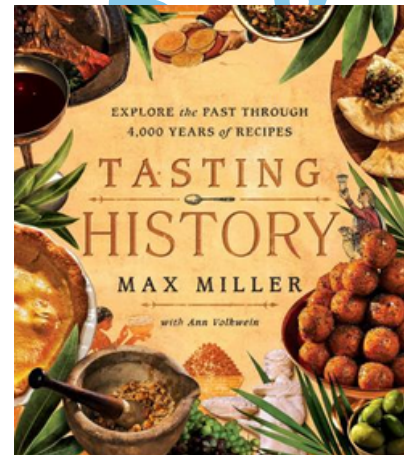
INKTASTIC ART

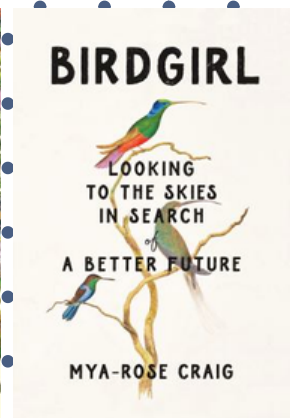
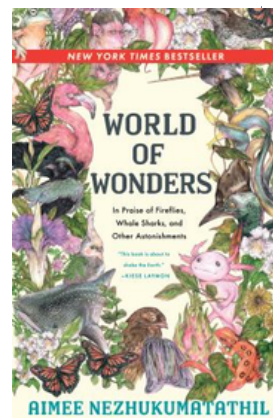
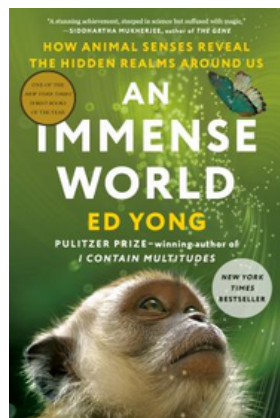
TASTE OF HISTORY
